**Are you travelling or coming back to
Portugal with your pets
(not dogs, cats and birds) from
countries outside the European Union?**

**Learn that you can only enter in Portugal with these
animals:**

- With an Authorization delivered by DGAV
- With specific health documentation
**Health Certificate (which should include, as applicable, the
health conditions required by the General Food and
Veterinary Directorate - DGAV)**



**These animals are checked in Travellers' Points
of Entry (e.g. airports)**

**If this check shows failure of these rules, the
animals are sent back to their origin, or, as a last
resort, the Community Legislation provides for
their euthanasia**



**Pet Animals here mentioned are those travelling
with their owners or another person on their behalf
up to a number of 5 and not intended for sale or
transferred to another owner. If travelling with
more than 5 animals check DGAV website:**

These rules do not apply to

**Andorra, Gibraltar, Greenland, Faroe Islands,
Iceland, Liechtenstein, Monaco, Norway,
San Marino, Switzerland and Vatican.**

**Get information for these countries on the
DGAV website.**

- The entry of live animals in Portugal require the
intervention of the National Institute for Nature
Conservation and Forest, **ICNF**
- Check the **Company Carrier**, with respect to
matters relating to the **Transport of the Animal**
- In most cases **your trip is scheduled in advance.**
Do the same to obtain information concerning
your pets. Remember that it might be done
vaccines/analyses to your pets and that can take
some time.
